RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF SUNSET METROPOLITAN DISTRICT CONCERNING INACTIVE STATUS

At a regular meeting of the Board of Directors of Sunset Metropolitan District, El Paso County, Colorado, held at 10:00 A.M., on Friday, the 14th day of November, 2014, at 421 South Tejon Street, Suite 250, Colorado Springs, Colorado, a quorum was present, via teleconference, and the following resolution was adopted by the Board of Directors (the "Board") for Sunset Metropolitan District (the "District"):

WHEREAS, the District was organized as a special district by order of the District Court for El Paso County, Colorado, dated March 31, 1986; and

WHEREAS, the Board has a duty to perform certain statutory obligations in order to assure the efficient operation of the District; and

WHEREAS, Section 32-1-104(3)(a), C.R.S. provides that a special district qualifying as an "inactive special district" as hereinafter defined pursuant to Section 32-1-103(9.3), C.R.S., may adopt a resolution describing and affirming its qualification for inactive status and further describing its current compliance with each of the requirements specified in Section 32-1-104(5), C.R.S.; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 32-1-104(5), C.R.S., inactive special districts are exempt from compliance with the provisions of Section 29-1-101 et seq., C.R.S. (Budget Law); Section 39-5-101 et seq., C.R.S. (Certification of Mill Levy); Section 32-1-306, C.R.S. (Map); Section 32-1-809, C.R.S. (Notice to Electors); Section 32-1-104(2), C.R.S. (Annual Contact Notification); Section 32-1-903, C.R.S. (Meetings); Section 29-1-201 et seq., C.R.S. (List of Intergovernmental Contracts); Section 29-1-601 et seq., C.R.S. (Local Government Audit Law); and Section 39-1-101 et seq., C.R.S. (Notice of Boundary Changes/Intent to Levy); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 104.8(3), C.R.S., the recording of a public disclosure statement is not required while any special district is on inactive status; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 32-1-103(9.3), C.R.S., a special district qualifies as an "inactive special district" if the district:

- (i) Is in a predevelopment stage that has no residents other than those who lived within the district's boundaries prior to the formation of the district;
- (ii) Does not have any business or commercial ventures or facilities within its boundaries;
- (iii) Has not issued any general obligation or revenue debt and does not have any financial obligations outstanding or contracts in effect that require performance by the district during the time the district is inactive;
- (iv) Has not imposed a mill levy for tax collection in that fiscal year:

- (v) Anticipates no receipt of revenue and has no planned expenditures, except for statutory compliance in that fiscal year;
- (vi) Has no operation or maintenance responsibility for any facilities, and
- (vii) Files "Notice of Inactive Status" pursuant to Section 32-1-104(3), C.R.S.; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the District qualifies for inactive status and has concluded that it would be in the best interest of the District to become an inactive special district.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF SUNSET METROPOLITAN DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Board hereby asserts that the District qualifies as an "inactive special district" as defined by Section 32-1-103(9.3), C.R.S. and affirms the following:
 - a. The District is in a predevelopment stage and has no residents other than those who lived within the district's boundaries prior to the formation of the district, if any.
 - b. The District does not have any business or commercial ventures or facilities within its boundaries.
 - c. The District has not issued any general obligation or revenue debt and does not have any financial obligations outstanding or contracts in effect that require performance by the District during the time the District is inactive.
 - d. The District has not imposed a mill levy for tax collection in fiscal years 2014 and 2015.
 - e. The District anticipates it will receive no revenue and has no planned expenditures, except for statutory compliance in fiscal year 2014 and 2015.
 - f. The District has no operation or maintenance responsibility for any facilities.
 - g. The District is in compliance with each of the requirements specified in Section 32-1-104(5), C.R.S.
- 2. The Board hereby declares the District to be an inactive special district, subject to the requirements of Sections 32-1-104(3)-(5), C.R.S. during inactive status, effective upon filing of a Notice of Inactive Status with the applicable entities set forth in Paragraph 3 herein.

- 3. The Board directs legal counsel to file a Notice of Inactive Status, on behalf of the District, with the El Paso County Board of County Commissioners; the El Paso County Treasurer, Assessor, and Clerk and Recorder; the District Court in and for the County of El Paso, Colorado; the State Auditor; and the Colorado Division of Local Government, on or before December 15, 2014.
- 4. Commencing with the filing of the Notice of Inactive Status and until such time as otherwise directed by the Board, the Board hereby directs legal counsel and any other appropriate persons(s) as may be selected by Two Rivers Water & Farming Company, TR El Paso Land LLC, or their assigns and successors, to perform, on behalf of the District, all statutory and service plan requirements that the District is not otherwise exempt from performing pursuant to Section 32-1-104(5), C.R.S. including, but not limited to, filing Notice of Continuing Inactive Status with the State Auditor and the Division, conducting elections, and filing annual reports.
- 5. This Resolution shall take effect on the date and at the time of its adoption.
